Request for Proposals LiDAR Acquisition

The Hoh Tribe is seeking proposals to obtain updated LiDAR in the Usual and Accustomed Area of the Tribe.

Proposal should include the following deliverables/specifications:

- Hoh Watershed (approximately 167,000 acres) Topographic LiDAR acquisition, processing, and products according to USGS 3DEP Lidar Base Specification requirements (GIS shapefile will be provided)
- Supplemental vegetation and building point classification
- Hydro-enforced bare earth DEM
- 4-Band Multispectral Imagery
- 2' Contours
- Building footprints
- Topo bathymetric LiDAR acquisition, processing, and products for the Hoh River corridor (approximately 7,800 acres, GIS shapefile will be provided)

Proposals will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- Completeness of proposal
- Experience and past performance with similar projects
- Ability to meet deliverables/specifications described above
- Cost
- Demonstrated quality of services

All prices quoted by the vendor must be fully itemized in whole US dollars and inclusive of all taxes and expenses.
