Request for Proposals Forest Management Plan Update

The Hoh Tribe is seeking proposals to update the Tribe's Forest Management Plan and stand-based forest inventory. The last inventory was completed in 2013.

Proposal should include the following deliverables/specifications:

- Prepare Forest Inventory Field Procedures Guide
- Update GIS layer with forest stands and areas designated as “off based” or “not managed as forestland”
- Using Forest Projection System, conduct a stand-based forest inventory on approximately 645 acres designated as “forestland.” For each stand prepare a narrative describing stand attributes, forest health issues, management needs, and operational constraints.
- Conduct Forest Road Inventory (approximately 8.2 miles of forest roads). Develop database of forest road attributes including; mapping of forest road segments, locate culvert and stream crossing locations, identify areas of concern, identify potential gravel sources, and map invasive species along roadsides. Deliverables include an attributed GIS database for all forest roads on the reservation and a summary report describing any remedial work that is needed to maintain the forest road infrastructure.

Proposals will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- Completeness of proposal
- Experience and past performance with similar projects
- Ability to meet deliverables/specifications described above
- Cost
- Demonstrated quality of services

All prices quoted by the vendor must be fully itemized in whole US dollars and inclusive of all taxes and expenses.
