

Olympic Coast National Marine Sanctuary Anniversary Poster

We are reaching out to tribal artists of each of the Coastal Treaty Tribes to help in the development of a poster that is representative of the Olympic Coast. Working with the Olympic Coast Intergovernmental Policy Council, it was determined that each of the four Coastal Treaty Tribes would work with tribal artists in their community to design one species that will be represented on the Olympic Coast National Marine Sanctuary (OCNMS) poster. We are soliciting tribal depictions (also referred to as line art) of the following species:

- ❖ Hoh Tribe - Salmon
- ❖ Makah Tribe - Humpback whale tail
- ❖ Quileute Tribe - Orca whale diving into the ocean
- ❖ Quinault Indian Nation - Dungeness crab

Respective Tribal Councils, or their designated representative(s), will select the art/artist. The selected artist(s) will receive \$500.

OCNMS Poster

Deadline: October 20, 2023

The Office of National Marine Sanctuaries (ONMS) celebrated its 50th anniversary last year. As part of this celebration, ONMS has been developing posters for each sanctuary site (<https://sanctuaries.noaa.gov/posters/>). Olympic Coast National Marine Sanctuary is in the process of developing the poster for our site.

OCNMS recognizes the vibrant contemporary communities of the Hoh Tribe, Makah Tribe, Quileute Tribe, and the Quinault Indian Nation have forged inseparable ties to the ocean environment. OCNMS has worked with the Intergovernmental Policy Council (IPC) to solicit input on a poster that is representative of the Olympic Coast region.

Working with the IPC it was determined that each of the four Coastal Treaty Tribes would be in charge of one species to be represented on the OCNMS poster. We are soliciting tribal depictions (also referred to as line art) of the following species:

- ❖ Hoh Tribe - Salmon (minimum size 1.5" x 3")
- ❖ Makah Tribe - Humpback whale tail (minimum size 2" X 3")
- ❖ Quileute Tribe - Orca whale diving into the ocean (minimum size 4" X 6")
- ❖ Quinault Indian Nation - Dungeness crab (minimum size 2.5" X 2.5")

The selected artist(s) will receive \$500 for their work and their name will be listed on the poster.

Who is eligible to participate?

Enrolled tribal member of the Hoh Tribe, Makah Tribe, Quileute Tribe, or Quinault Indian Nation.

REQUIREMENTS:

- ❖ All works submitted for this contest must be entirely original works created by the artist.
- ❖ A maximum of two entries per artist will be allowed.
- ❖ Although a computer graphic is preferred, any art medium that can be converted to digital format may be used.
- ❖ Accepted file types are: JPEG, PNG, TIFF, AI, or EPS. Make sure your files are high resolution and are easy to see. Minimum artwork size is 300 dpi.
- ❖ With each entry, be sure to include the artist's name, age, and tribal affiliation.
- ❖ For all artists under age 18, a parent or guardian must approve the entry and sign the provided copyright license form.

Design development considerations:

- ❖ Keep it simple
- ❖ No drop shadows
- ❖ Minimum artwork size is 300 dpi, but can accept any size larger. Since the art may be displayed at a small size on the poster, design must be easy to visually understand at that size.

There should be one entry form and one copyright release form for each entry (up to two entries per artist). Please ensure that the entry and release forms are filled out completely and legibly. All entries must be submitted to the respective Tribal Council or their designated representative(s) no later than **October 20, 2023**.
