HOH TRIBE 2024 OCEAN GROUNDFISH REGULATION

FISHERY:

Commercial

TARGET SPECIES:

Groundfish

MGMT. PERIOD:

January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024

MGMT. AREA:

Quileute River (47 deg. 54' 18" N. latitude)

Quinault River (47 deg. 21' 00" N. latitude)

OPEN: January 01, 2024

CLOSES: DECEMBER 31, 2024

GEAR RESTRICTIONS: Non-Trawl Gear

LANDING RESTRICTIONS AND HARVEST GUIDELINES:

LINGCOD: 600 Lbs. daily trip limit, 1800 Lbs./week round wt. (24 inches minimum length)

BLACK ROCKFISH: Unlimited (10,000 pound cumulative tribal guota south of Destruction Island).

THORNYHEADS: 300 Lbs. daily trip limit (longspine and shortspine combined)

CANARY ROCKFISH: 300 Lbs. daily trip limit
YELLOWEYE ROCKFISH: 100 Lbs. daily trip limit
WIDOW ROCKFISH: 300 Lbs. daily trip limit

YELLOW TAIL ROCKFISH: 300 Lbs. daily trip limit

MINOR SLOPE ROCKFISH: 4,000 Lbs./ 2 month time period (300 Lbs./day per each species)

MINOR NEARSHORE ROCKFISH: 5,000 Lbs./2 month time period (300 Lbs./day per each species)

MINOR SHELF ROCKFISH: 300 Lbs. daily trip limit

PACIFIC OCEAN PERCH: 1,800 Lbs./ 2 month time period

SOLE SSP. INCLUDING PETRALE, REX AND DOVER: 100,000 lbs / season limit

ARROWTOOTH FLOUNDER: 30,000 lbs / daily trip limit

CATCH REPORTING: All catch data and fish catch tickets shall be provided to the Hoh Tribal Fisheries Management Biologist within 24 hours of Landing. All catch must have been reported prior to subsequent departure.

HARVEST SAMPLING: All catch shall be made available for sampling by the Hoh Tribal Fisheries Management Biologist or Hoh Tribal Staff as necessary for biological sampling.
