Fishery: Subsistence, Sport Fishery: In-River

Target Species: Steelhead and Salmon

Season: August 31, 2026, through December 06, 2026

Catch Area: Hoh – Mouth upstream to headwaters
South Fork Hoh – Mouth upstream to headwaters

Legal Gear: Rod & Reel: 1 Rod Per Person
Fishing Permitted During Daylight Hours Only
Snagging is Prohibited

Size Limit: None

Catch Limit: 3 Salmon and/or Steelhead caught per day

Notes: All fish caught for subsistence must be marked by removal of the dorsal fin.

Fish harvested under this regulation may not be sold according to the provisions of the General Fishing Ordinance No. 12-05-2018-03.

CATCH REPORTING: Fishers must report to: fishreporting@hohtribe-nsn.org, or call 360-374-6737 or report directly to the Natural Resources Office all of their catch after each trip and include date of catch and number of each species. Authorized tribal fisherman must have in their possession a Tribal identification card when fishing off of the reservation. This regulation is subject to emergency closure.
